When I go back to school I will have to try to catch my coughs and sneezes in a tissue.



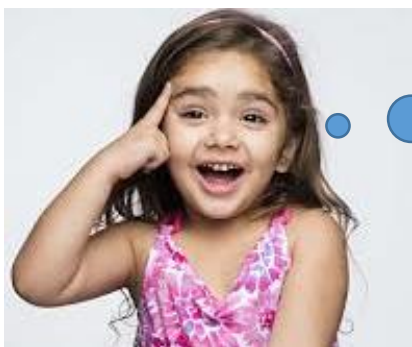
This will stop me from spreading germs and help keep me safe.
